7. Creating Your Catalogue


7.1 Categories/ Products

It is without a doubt, a beneficial factor in providing an eCommerce store that is user friendly and straight forward to consumers. A good navigation is essential, therefore the less clicks the better. Therefore it's best to have your catalogue organized into different categories.

Categories define how all the products on your site are organized. You should choose a hierarchical structure for your store that will make sense to your customers therefore making it easy to locate your items.



- To create a category, simply click on "new category".
- Fill in the required information and click "save".



• Within categories, you can create subcategories, simply double click on the category and click on new category.

Manufacturers

• Before creating product profiles, if you would like to indicate the manufacturers of your products, you must create manufacturer names. To do so, click under **Manufacturers**.



• To create new Manufacturers, simply click "insert".




• Fill in the new information and click "save".

Creating Product Profiles

- Once you've organized your catalog into categories and/or subcategories and created Manufacturers' names, you can create product profiles.
- Select the category your product belongs to by double clicking it. (ex. DVD Movies)



• If there are subcategories, select the one your product belongs in. (ex. Cartoons)



• If there are further categories, click until you've reached the end.



Click on "new product" and you will be brought to the following page:

Product Status: Simply means if you have it in stock now or not.

Date Available: If the product is not released yet, indicate the date of when it will be. If it is

released already, leave it empty.

Product Manufacturer: The manufacturer of the product.

Product Name: The name of the product. **Product Description:** Describe the product.

Product Quantity: The amount of product you have in stock.

Product Model: The model of the product.

Product Image: It's best to have an image of the product so customers know what it looks like.

Product URL: Best to provide a link of the product so customers could find more information

regarding the product.

Product Price: The price at which you are selling the product.

Tax Class: The tax class for all products being sold is "All Taxable Goods".

Product Weight: Indicate the weight of the product in its correct units.

Make sure that the information you provide is comprehensive. Provide pictures and brief descriptions to help customers understand what is being presented.





7.2 Product Attributes

If you are selling a product that comes in different sizes, colours, or versions, etc. you could indicate it under Product Attributes.

For example, you own an online store that sells electronic devices such as CD players. You are selling the newest model of a Sony Discman that comes in silver, metallic blue, and black. Creating a product attribute allows your customers (when buying the Sony Discman) to choose from a pull-down box the colour of Discman they wish to buy before adding it to their shopping cart.

If a certain colour, size, version, etc. costs different (more/less) than the original value, you could indicate it here as well.

Creating Product Attributes

Product Options

• Under product options is where you input the name of the product that comes in different varieties (in this case, Sony Discman D-E360), click **insert**.




Option Values

- This is where you indicate the different versions, colours, size, etc.
- In the pull down box, find your product. (In our case, the Sony Discman D-E360)
- In the second box, type in the description (in our case, silver)
- Finally click insert.
- Continue to do the above steps until you're done indicating the different versions.

Product Attributes

- If you are selling the different versions at different prices, this is where you indicate it.
- Let's say the Sony Discman D-E360 is \$149.99, but you want to sell the metallic blue one \$5 more, then in the value price field, type in 5.00 and click insert. If however the metallic blue Discman is 5.00 cheaper, under prefix, type (-) instead.
- If the remaining versions are sold at \$149.99, then in the "value price" field, type in 0.000.
