8.1 Payment

- Below is a list of different payment module/gateway providers that you can use to process the payments from your clients.
- Before selecting for a desired payment gateway provider, please make sure that you have an activated merchant account
 with the provider.*
- To enable, simply click on the install button on the right. To disable, click on the remove button on the right.
- When enabling a payment gateway, please make sure to update your company information. (Please do not use default information!)



- 3. Input the e-mail address you've registered with PayPal (Or any other payment gateway provider)*.
- 4. Select the Transaction Currency you would like to use.
- 5. <u>Payment Zone:</u> You only allow this payment method to a certain geographic zone. Zones not selected are not allowed to use such payment method.
- 6. <u>Set Order Status:</u> After using this payment method, it displays the status of the transaction.
- 7. Sort Order Display: the lower the number, the higher the display priority of the payment method in the check out page.



Tax Class:

Select "GST Shipping Class" as your Tax Class. Depending on where your customers live, by selecting "GST Shipping Class", the receipt will indicate the appropriate tax on the shipping fee. If your customers live outside of Canada, no shipping tax will be applied. If your customers live within Canada, the appropriate provincial tax (GST/PST/HST) will be applied to the shipping fee.

Shipping Zone:

The permission to allow only a certain area to use this payment of shipping. Areas other than the selected area are restricted to use this form of payment.
